

Current Sermon Series: The Sermon on the Mount: Built on the Rock

Most of us are familiar with bits and pieces of the Sermon on the Mount. We have certainly heard, or at least heard of, the beatitudes. But what was the point of this longest sermon recorded by Jesus? John Stott has noted that the Sermon on the Mount is "probably the best known part of the teaching of Jesus, though arguably it is the least understood, and certainly it is the least obeyed." In our sermon series through the Sermon on the Mount, we will see that Jesus was giving a manifesto for how Christians are to live as citizens of heaven, while still being residents of a sinful world. But this is no easy task, and the sermon will challenge us to think differently about obedience. It will challenge us to think deeply about grace and law. And it will challenge us to think soberly about what it means to be a disciple.



Our Brotherhood had a productive and rewarding year of activities in 2025. We took advantage of opportunities to build ramps for 8 people who are dependent on wheelchairs and replaced a dilapidated porch for an elderly lady who could no longer access the front of her home. The Horry County Council on Aging and the Rotary Club of Conway have considered our group to be dependable allies when help is needed for those who could not otherwise afford these necessary improvements. The Brotherhood, along with other groups, have been engaged in other activities such as: replacing mulch in the playground, beautification of the parking lot and church grounds, Christmas decorations, serving as waiters for the women's events and serving dinner for 240 students at Conway High School. We have also hosted outreach events such as the Wild Game Dinner and a Fish Fry where our men were encouraged to invite guests who might be unchurched and, better still, lost.



While all of these activities are important and hopefully bring glory to God, they are also intended to build relationships through fellowship with each other. Our main purpose has been and is to promote fellowship among the men of our church and community. First, we want to recognize and identify each other by name. Second, we desire fellowship over a meal with other Christian men as well as those who may be lost but seeking a relationship with Christ; Jesus often ate with his disciples and others. Third, we want to prioritize developing relationships by being inclusive and encouraging so that each man can become confident in his abilities when called to serve as a disciple for our Lord.



The Brotherhood generally meets on the second Sunday of each month at 5:00 PM in the NCBC Fellowship Hall. All males are welcome regardless of age, church affiliation, or condition of their salvation. We hope you will consider joining us for dinner at our next meeting on February 8th.


- Pray for our Student Ministry

Pastor's Note

Nehemiah 8:9

“...For all the people wept as they heard the words of the Law.”



Nehemiah 8–10 chronicles one of the most powerful movements of God in the entire Old Testament. In many ways, it serves as a blueprint for discovering the authentic marks of revival and spiritual awakening we ought to long for in our day.

While many marks of revival are within these chapters, one stands out in chapter 8:9-12: an overwhelming conviction of sin from the faithful preaching of the Word of God. As the law of God was read and explained, it brought a deep awareness of sin against God, and suddenly the people saw themselves as they really were, sinners before a holy God.

This is glorious because before one can receive the Good News, one must first accept the bad news: being a sinner. This should not surprise us, because throughout the Bible and church history, every great awakening has been accompanied by an overwhelming, deep conviction of sin.

One example occurred in 1995 at Coggin Avenue Baptist Church in Brownwood, Texas. Under the preaching of John Avant, a great outpouring of God's Spirit began among college students. It began on January 22nd during a Sunday morning service. At the end of the service, two college students from Howard Payne University began confessing their sins and weeping publicly. Soon, other college students began to do the same thing. This went on for 3.5 hours and would continue for many weeks!

Revival was breaking out in this little town in Texas, yet it didn't stop there. It soon spread and launched a movement on many college campuses across our nation. In May, John Avant went to Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and began preaching in its chapel. For 7 hours, seminary professors and students came forward to confess their sins. Just like in Nehemiah's day, it all began with an overwhelming conviction of sin from the faithful preaching of the Word of God!

May we be encouraged as we witness God's work among our college students. Let's pray the Word of God continues its convicting work among us all, leading to joyful obedience and lasting fruit!
