
The Great Pursuit - Longing for a Deeper Relationship With God

Note From Pastor Jay

“The Great Pursuit”



This year’s church wide focus is The Great Pursuit: Longing for a Deeper Relationship with God. The goal of this year is to provide both the tools and the desire for each church member to have a more intimate, personal, meaningful relationship with God. As I began praying about what this year’s theme would be, I thought about all of the amazing things that God is doing in and through our congregation. There is so much to celebrate! But God kept pressing in on my thoughts the idea that our church members know a lot about God, we have good theology, and good teaching, but the question kept coming back...do they really know God? Do they experience his presence and leading consistently in their lives? This is the heart of our focus this year.

But I was not prepared for how well it would be received. Since preaching the initial sermon and starting the Sunday evening book study, I have had dozens of the same conversation. Something like, “I am so excited about this year’s focus. This is exactly what my heart has been longing for and struggling with, but I couldn’t ever put it into words. Now I realize I need to be pursuing God.” I think this is an important topic at an important time for our church. All of us, no matter where we are in our relationship with God, can find more of Him if we look. He is infinitely good, so there is always more to see and savor.

So let me encourage you to engage with our theme for this year. If you work to pursue God, He will honor that effort with revelation. If you have not picked up a copy of our theme book The Pursuit of God by A. W. Tozer, we still have some free copies available at the Next Steps desk. Whatever you do this year, commit to pursuing God, because as He has promised, if you look for Him, He will be found!

Does anybody REALLY know what time it is? The whole daylight saving time vs. standard time stuff is for the birds. Did you know just about every country just does their own thing? WHAT?! For example, Morocco observes DST for 11 months, with the only exception being the month of Ramadan. So for one month each year, every clock in Morocco is wrong and they are just living an hour behind...because who really believes they are changing all those clocks just for a few weeks. We all know it takes a couple of weeks for us to change ours, right? Even in the US, we can't agree. Every state and even some counties can do what they please. A couple of years ago, I went out west towards the Grand Canyon, spending some time roaming between Utah and Arizona. I managed to find myself staying in a county that not only straddled a time zone line but also did not observe DST like its neighbors. My brain never did figure out if it was one, two, or four hours off from my hardwired eastern standard time. Here's what I do know...I love sunlight. I hate driving home in the dark and feeling stuck inside. I love the sun, and I love my time in the sun. Time is fleeting. It moves on with or without us. Ephesians 5 tells us to make the most of our opportunities because the days are evil. Use your time wisely and not on things that pull us away from God. Students, I know you face endless distractions and constant pressure put on your time, but imagine what could happen if we used our time to serve, build relationships, and experience God in real ways. Changing our clocks is a small act, but doesn't it change how we see our day? Suddenly, we are given a new and fresh opportunity! An opportunity to give that time back to God in ways that make an impact on us and the world around us. So as we "spring forward" this season, let it be more than a clock change. Let it challenge you to use your time wisely and in service to your relationship with the Lord.
