Pastor's Note

Proverbs 12:25

Anxiety in a man's heart weighs him down, but a good word makes him glad.

I trust I don't have to spend a ton of time convincing you that anxiety is at an all-time high today. A quick Google search yields an avalanche of articles and statistics testifying to this. Whether due to social media comparisons, financial stress, health issues, increasing isolation, or just the daily grind of life, people today are more anxious and stressed than ever.

The effect of anxiety, as the proverb says, is that it weighs us down. In other words, it saps our strength, steals our joy, and drains our lives. Anxiety is the thief of all that is good and beautiful in life.

Thankfully, Solomon doesn't leave us hanging. While anxiety weighs us down, "a good word makes him glad." Wow—so simple! This immediately made me think of the importance of encouraging one another in the church.

A church member dealing with some health issues said something to me the other day that hit me. He said, "Sometimes I just need some encouragement." My heart went out to him. How often are people all around us weighed down by anxiety and the cares of life, aching for someone to give them "a good word"? I think it is safe to say that 99% of the people you talk to today need some encouragement.

In his book Love One Another, author and professor Jerry Sittser put it this way:

"Encouragement is to people in the church what maintenance is to cars and trucks. We have to encourage people to help keep them going as disciples of Jesus over the long haul. When our brothers and sisters in Christ are lacking in zeal and passion, when they lose heart, when they're discouraged and facing disappointment, we must come alongside them with words of encouragement."

Here's what's cool: If we will commit to encouraging others, the Bible tells us we will be encouraged in turn (see Prov. 11:25). Brothers and sisters, let's not let one day go by without encouraging someone with a good word—that will make them glad!


