

In 1887, Harmon Palmer patented a machine that produced blocks of concrete for the purpose of building. Palmer could barely contain his excitement over his invention believing he was going to strike gold. Unfortunately, the blocks were simply too big, too heavy to lift, and too heavy to transport to job sites. No one wanted them. 17 years later, Harmon patented another concrete block, this time with 2 giant holes in it. The cinderblock as we know it, weighed one-third of its original weight, was easy to carry and transport, and thanks to the holes, it became a much superior insulator than the original and astonishingly could even support more weight than its predecessor. By removing the unnecessary, it became a far better product that has now stood the test of time. Be in prayer for our students as we head to Fort Caswell this month for our Fall Retreat. Our Middle Schoolers will be focusing how to grow our relationship with Christ in the busy world we live. We will be "Pausing" the outside noise to focus on our own quiet time with the Lord...removing the weight so we can focus on Jesus!
