Current Sermon Series: The Sermon on the Mount: Built on the Rock

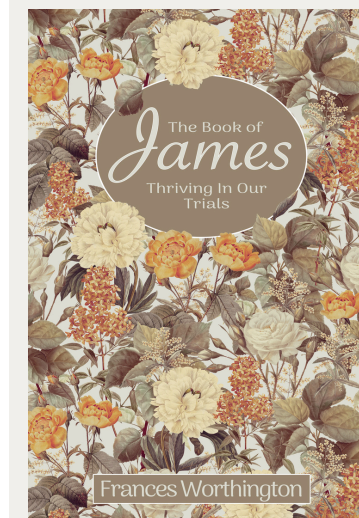
Most of us are familiar with bits and pieces of the Sermon on the Mount. We have certainly heard, or at least heard of, the beatitudes. But what was the point of this longest sermon recorded by Jesus? John Stott has noted that the Sermon on the Mount is "probably the best known part of the teaching of Jesus, though arguably it is the least understood, and certainly it is the least obeyed." In our sermon series through the Sermon on the Mount, we will see that Jesus was giving a manifesto for how Christians are to live as citizens of heaven, while still being residents of a sinful world. But this is no easy task, and the sermon will challenge us to think differently about obedience. It will challenge us to think deeply about grace and law. And it will challenge us to think soberly about what it means to be a disciple.

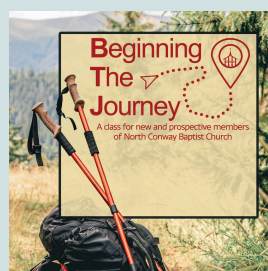
Psalm 100 says, "Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into His presence with singing! Know that the Lord, He is God! It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving, and His courts with praise! Give thanks to Him; bless His name! For the Lord is good; His steadfast love endures forever, and His faithfulness to all generations."

When we pursue God privately, get to know Him, worship Him, and dwell in His Word daily, there is only one response: worship!! One of my favorite quotes from John Piper is, "God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him."

Even if you are not in the music ministry, you still play a vital role in our corporate worship. Paul instructs the church in Colossians 3:16-17 to "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him."

What a gift it is to join our voices in singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with thankfulness in our hearts to God each time we gather for corporate worship. I look forward to worshipping with you on Sunday!

 - Pray for our upcoming camps that kids will be traveling to and from.

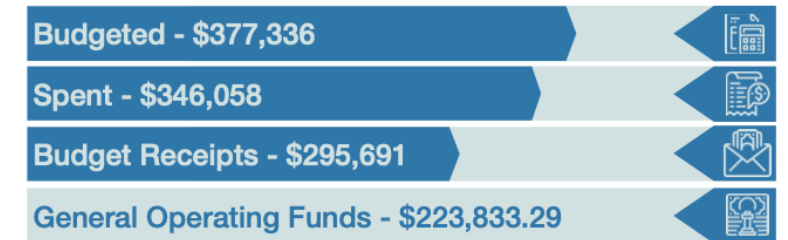
- Pray for our Student Ministry

Game Day and Lunch

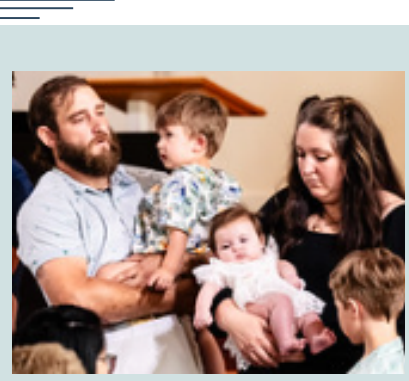
